- Work with legal teams at HSRI to negotiate and secure data use agreements with outside partners
- Advise other staff on research methodology, sampling, evaluation of pilots, and acceptable

- Guide development of dashboards/metric development/data definitions, with goal of creating a self-service reporting environment that will allow access to data and reports for all staff
- Facilitate team building for data team resources across agencies
- Work with technical HSRI team to give input to and approve functional design documents (FDDs) from technology vendor to ensure consistency with business needs
- Participate in strategic planning across state agencies related to large data projects and use of data (DataMart, All Payer Claims Database, Unified Health Infrastructure Project, and others)
